WHAT IS AN “I HOPE” STORYBOOK?

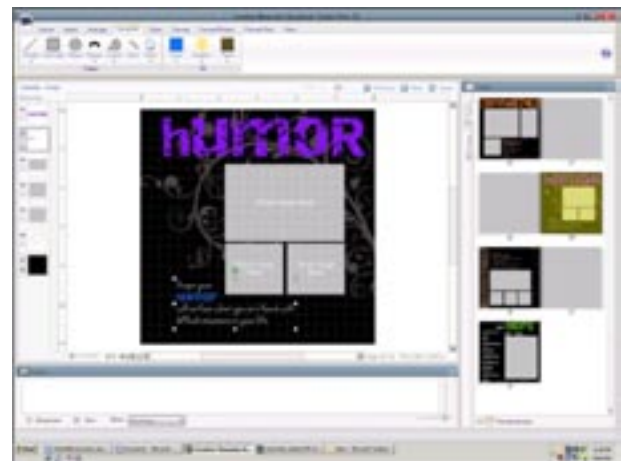
One of the greatest gifts a parent can give to a child is an album of hope. It's the gift of self-assurance and a sense of belonging. It shows children that they have a stable foundation and that they're a part of something larger than themselves. It tells children that they can be strong and believe in their dreams because they have a family supporting them. And we have validation of this belief from a child psychologist that believes as we do: this is one of the most important things you can give your children!



WHERE ARE THE PRE-DESIGNED PAGES?

1. Go to www.creativememories.com.au or www.creativememories.co.nz
2. Click Login at the top left corner of the screen and use your Digital Centre or VIP Rewards Club details to log in to your account.
3. Select Shop Products then click on Digital / Digital Content / 12x12 Predesigned Pages
4. Scroll to the bottom of the page to view the free Digital Content and add 12" x 12" Pre-designed Pages - I Hope to an order.
5. Follow the steps to obtain the pre-designed pages, (12" x 12" Pre-designed Pages - I Hope are free) click on the link in the email you receive to download it and import it into StoryBook Creator 3.0 Software.
6. Open StoryBook Creator 3.0 Software and start a new 12" x 12" StoryBook. Select the I Hope Pre-designed Pages and begin designing your book.

2. Select Cut & Fill
3. Select Rectangle and position the rectangle around the element you wish to re-colour, make sure everything around the element you want to separate is shaded.



CHANGING THE COLOUR OF TEXT

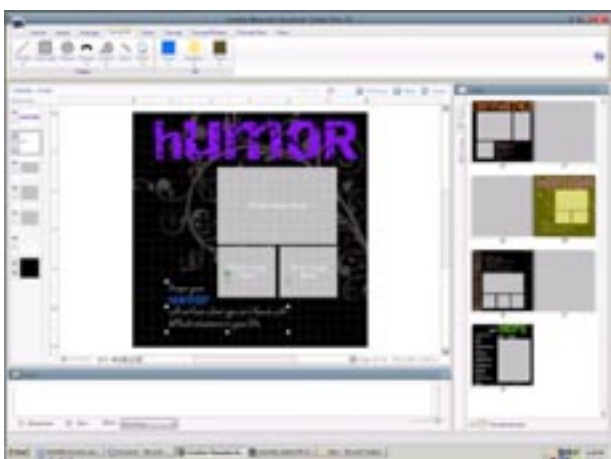
Single Expression Text:

1. Select the expression text you wish to change the colour of.
2. Select Cut & Fill; then Colour and select the colour you want to use.

Expression Text In the Middle of a Message:

1. Select the message.

4. Select “Cut around the shaded area”. This will ungroup the expression from the rest of the message. Click anywhere on the page away from the element and this will deselect all of the elements.
5. Click on the single element you wish to change the colour.
6. Select “Cut & Fill”; select colour and then select the colour you would like to use. After you are happy with the colour change, it is recommended you regroup the elements to allow you to move the group together. This is easily done by selecting one section, hold shift key, select second section; Right click and select “Group” from Grouping option.



ADDING EXPRESSION TEXT

1. Insert text box – use a large box – recommended font size is 144.
2. Type word you would like to add
3. Select the font Destroy; select a point size of at least 120; select your colour
4. A Mix of Upper and Lower Case provides variety
